I was on the AAVSO Strategic Planning Committee. Professionally, I led and participated on developing AND IMPLEMENTING multiple Strategic Plans over a 40 year career in the semiconductor and semiconductor capital equipment industries.

I consider myself a data-driven person. If metrics show a plan isn't working, then I am very good with re-evaluating the plan and moving in a new direction. If no data exists, I can use a gut feel approach, but moving slower to change and with "milder" changes.

# Please describe your experience and accomplishments in the area of advocacy and public relations.

For AAVSO I advocated for our participation in NEAF/NEAIF and Stellafane for outreach. I chair a session of talks annually at Stellafane on Pro-Am Collaboration, making presentations and finding other interesting speakers. I have given about 10 presentations (most remotely) to astronomy clubs on various AAVSO centric topics. For NH AARP Tax Aide, I am the NH marketing lead, giving presentations about our service and acquiring volunteers. I write collateral material, have done one CATV interview program of 1 hr duration. Professionally, I mainly held project and Product Management positions developing marketing campaigns, collateral, product plans, etc.

# Please describe your experience and accomplishments in the area of Education and Training.

Professionally, I have some experience working with Training Departments in developing training materials for new products. As a School Board member, I was on the Curriculum Committee for 4 years, helping guide district curriculum and evaluation programs. Because I am NOT a professional educator, I listened closely to recommendations from the professionals.

#### Astronomy Research Projects

Identifying and pursuing Astronomy Research projects with Citizen-science activities will be an important initiative for AAVSO in the next few years (including identifying research questions/problems, recruiting participants, organizing and leading teams, defining approaches, forming professional-amateur collaborations, identifying funding needs, evaluating interim results and course-corrections, reaching conclusions, publication).

In the area of Pro-Am collaboration, I have chaired several Pro-Am sessions of talks at Stellafane, an amateur astronomy convention in VT hosting upwards of 1,000 attendees. As part of this, I actively sought and obtained both amateur and professionals to speak on this topic.

#### Citizen Science

AAVSO is one of the oldest and most respected Citizen Science organizations in the world. Expanding on this legacy will be an important initiative during the next few years (including

engaging participants both within and beyond the AAVSO community, expanding opportunities for collecting new data and for mining existing databases, maintaining primary focus on achieving tangible scientific outcomes, engaging both professional and non-professional participants, maintaining communication among team members).

#### How much experience do you have with Citizen Science

Moderate Experience: Actively participated.

Please describe your experience and accomplishments in the area of Citizen Science As a participant in citizen science, I have submitted over 50,000 datapoints into the AAVSO database. Weekly I receive updates on the use of my data. Typically, one or two people download some of my data to analyze weekly. It's a great feeling! My data was used in 1 paper, with me being listed as a coauthor. In another case, a Belgian Professor thanked me for following "his" star, and I began following several more that he needed data on.

For example, many of the challenges of running an arts organization may feed directly effectively managing and motivating volunteers in a Citizen Science organization.

In college I ran an on-campus coffeehouse. Finding free/cheap talented performers, budgeting the coffeehouse, etc.
