- Aug 30-31 ~~29-30~~ Padilla. Photos of thin crescent moon and Venus, Jupiter & Saturn conjunction in twilight. Prime focus & piggy backed exposures. M17, M20, M31, M33. Temp. 68-63°. Windy part of eve. Closed at 4 am.
- Aug. 31 Poyer + Padilla. No wind! Moon + planets conj.
Sept. 1 photos again in early evening. Used astrograph as
30% 60°F RFT visually till 1 A.M. Retired.
- 9/1-2/8 Diff for visual estimates, completed 10, lots of wind, good transparency. Worked at the microwave station apparently all night.
